STEP 4: Whakapapa

We acknowledge that whānau are at different stages of connecting with whakapapa. We want to connect with you as much you want to connect with us, the below helps us do that. This is where we capture the details of your Whakapapa to enable us to verify your connection to Ngāi Te Rangī iwi. The goal is to demonstrate this relationship by providing us with details of the side or sides of your family that have this link. It is important to note the following:

- We need you to provide as much relevant information as possible, the further back you can go the easiest it will be for our Hapū verifiers to confirm your relationship to the Hapū you have chosen. **As a general rule, at least four generations are required.**
- We only need details of your Ngāi Te Rangī lineage, as this is what we use to confirm your Hapū affiliation
- We need "legal names" for each whānau member to enable us to cross reference their details, however, please provide a preferred or common name
- Maiden names are preferred when they have changed due to marriage
- Please refer to this example Whakapapa to see what a good set of information looks like as this will make our verification process go smoothly and reduce requests for additional information

Please provide the details of Parent One. If this parent is where your Ngāi Te Rangī whakapapa comes from, choose to "Add" new generations until you're sure the connection has been made to the Hapū. Please note: you only need to provide information relevant to your Ngāi Te Rangī whakapapa, if a tupuna has no affiliation to our Hapū or Iwi, we don't need their details to be included for verification e.g. if your Father's mother was Pakeha.
